

Fresh Fire Fellowship Family Retreat Celebration

Info Sheet

- DRESS IS CASUAL – Jeans, T-shirts and bare feet are okay!
- Campfires every night (weather permitting) after evening services – Hotdogs will be provided - Please bring your own snacks and s'more fixins'.
- Parents who have young children may want to bring toys / “playing-in-the-creek” toys, etc. A large sized sandbox is also available for kids – bring appropriate sandbox toys if so desired.

** If you are tenting, you will need a tent and appropriate rain cover and sufficient preparations for outdoor elements and weather conditions (a suggestion if you are tenting – bring an extra tarp / sheet of plastic / easy-up canopy, etc. to help provide additional protection in case of rain. Also, if you like some light during the night, we recommend bringing a Tiki lantern or Citronella can, etc.)

ITEMS TO BRING:

- Pillow, Bedding, Air Mattress / Camping Pad - (bring extra warm bedding)
- Toiletries
- Towels
- Insect Repellant and Sunscreen
- Bible – in some form
- Lawn Chairs
- Flashlights / Headlamp / Lanterns
- Rain gear and umbrellas

PLEASE NOTE:

- For any administrative questions or inquiries, please see / contact Pastor Jordan
- Please bring extra bedding / blankets / warm clothing for sleeping arrangements. It can tend to get cool in NY throughout the night, so this is strongly recommended.
- Joshua Good will be the Grounds Security / Safety person.
- No minors leave the grounds without permission from those responsible for them.
- Parents are responsible for their own children!

Upon arrival, the tent campers will then be couriered in a trailer with their tent, luggage and gear to their designated campsite by a Fresh Fire Fellowship “chauffeur”. Please note, for persons tenting on the property, if their arrival time is later than 10:00 pm on Thursday evening, special arrangements will need to be made with Joshua Good (607-661-6067) before Thursday 12:00 pm via a DM message.

There will not be an “official service” Thursday evening. The “sanctuary tent” will be open for Prayer and Worship every morning from “early morning” – 8:00 am. During these prayer / worship times, please be mindful of campers / children that may still be sleeping in campsites in proximity.

Since we are located within the village limits of Andover, NY, we are obligated to the noise ordinance of the village. Quiet time will be from 10:30 pm – 7:30 am. Please no unnecessary or excessive noise during these hours.

There will be 2 meals served each day - there will not be a collective start time – all campers are responsible to come to the dining tent to acquire meals during the designated serving times. Brunch will be served from 8:30 – 9:30 am and Dinner will be served from 4:30 pm – 5:30 pm. There will be fruit and vegetables and fixings for PBJ sandwiches setting out for all to have in between mealtimes. All are welcome to help themselves to these provisions and provide for their families with these supplies and / or their own personal supplies in between mealtimes. If you have any dietary restrictions, you are responsible to meet those needs.

If campers wish to have a “campfire snack” (S’mores, finger foods, etc.) later in the evening, please bring your own supplies and maybe a few to share.
